

Dear UAM Band Campers,

We look forward to having you at camp. Here are a few things to help make your week more pleasant. Please contact us at 870-460-1060 if you have any further questions.

CHECK - IN

Sunday check in is from 12:30 to 4:00 at the Band Hall in the Performing Visual Arts Building *(behind the bookstore and across from Royer Hall).

The following will take place at check in:

*Pay any balance that is owed on your account.

Because there will be a lot of people in a small place **PLEASE DO NOT BRING BAGGAGE OR INSTRUMENTS TO CHECK IN!** You may unload these items at your dorm after afterwards.

AUDITIONS: 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.

IMMEDIATELY after you check in, move your things into your dorm room, then bring your horn over to the Band Hall to try out for placement in a band. There will be signs posted when you arrive directing you as to what room you are to tryout in. **AFTER** you complete your audition (this usually takes about 5 minutes) you may unpack in your dorm room.

DINNER:

Since the camp has grown to be so large this year, we will have to run 2 shifts for dinner on the first evening of camp. Directors will bus the students off campus to have dinner at Mazzio's Italian Eatery in Monticello. Campers will be taken to dinner based on what dorm they are located in. Dinner shifts will be as follows:

-Royer Hall- 4:30 p.m. – 5:30 p.m.

-Horsfall Hall – 5:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.

AUDITION RESULTS: 7:00 p.m.

All campers will need to meet in the Fine Arts Center Auditorium at 7:00 p.m. to find out which band they will be participating in during the rest of the week.

CONCERT TIMES:

Concerts will be on Friday June 24th at the Fine Arts Center Auditorium on the UAM campus. The concerts begin at 12:30 p.m.

The concerts will be video recorded by RBAA Films and may be bought for \$25. A video year book of the camp will also be available for \$30, including the concerts and interviews with students.

CHECK OUT:

All campers must be checked out of their dorm room **PRIOR** their concert.
